# Town Limb and Branch Pick-up Program

The Town of Chandler provides free pick-up and removal of tree and shrub trimmings and branches and limbs broken off by wind storms or other similar acts of God as a public service for its citizens. As such, the following policy is in place:

- Branches and limbs within the Town of Chandler that are broken off by wind storms or other acts of God that are 8 inches or less in diameter will be picked up and removed by the town in accordance with all of the provisions listed in this policy.
- All branches and limbs broken off by wind storm or other acts of God should be moved to the street side of the residence as near to the street as possible, but not on the street and not interfering with the use of the street, within 48 hours of the event.
- Branches and limbs should be cut into lengths not exceeding 4 feet unless the branch or limb exceeds 4 inches in diameter, in which event the branch or limb should be cut into lengths not exceeding 2 feet. No branch or limb of any length should exceed 50 pounds in weight.
- Branches and limbs should be stacked in an orderly fashion to facilitate efficient pick-up and removal.
- Removal of limbs, branches, shrub debris and other yard/landscaping material that is the result of regular pruning and maintenance is the responsibility of the property owner.

The Warrick County Recycling and Resource Management District's Pelzer Road location near Boonville provides free disposal of yard waste, including leaves, grass clippings, brush, shrubbery, pruning, and tree limbs or branches that are less than 3 inches in diameter. Tree limbs or branches that are more than 3 inches and diameter may also be disposed of at the Pelzer Road location at a cost of 2 cents per pound with a \$10 minimum charge. Leaves and grass clippings are accepted free of charge at the district's Chandler Satellite Site on Fuquay Road.
